



Compressed Gas Safety

- Regularly inspect tanks, regulators, and hoses for leaks, corrosion, cuts, bulges, and other defects
- Separate oxygen and other oxidant gases from fuel-gas cylinders
- Close valves and secure caps when not in use
- Verify all cylinders are properly labeled
- Only transport in carts designed for that purpose
- Ensure that the correct regulator is being used for the gas and cylinder type



Did You Know?

A punctured or heavily damaged compressed gas cylinder is akin to an unguided missile

Cylinders must be kept

- In an upright position
- Secured to permanent anchor points
- In a well-ventilated area away from heat, electrical current, and high traffic areas
